



Frequently Asked Questions Film submission

WHEN AND HOW CAN I SUBMIT MY FILM?

Afriff opens submission annually every

March – July, and movies can be submitted at

http://filmfreeway.com/AFRIFF

SINCE FILMS CAN BE IN ANY AFRICAN LANGUAGE, DO I REQUIRE A COPY WITH ENGLISH SUBTITLES?

All non-English films must be subtitled in English.

HOW ARE QUALIFYING FILMS SELECTED?

Qualifying films are selected through a pre-selection committee and a programmer.

I SUBMITTED MY FILM(S), HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY FILM(S) ARE SELECTED? You will be notified by the team.

I AM AN AFRICAN FILMMAKER WITH A MOVIE THAT IS MORE THAN ONE YEAR OLD, CAN I SUBMIT MY FILM FOR CONSIDERATION? Yes, you can but outside competition.

CAN I SUBMIT MY FILM FOR AFRIFF IF I ALREADY SUBMITTED IT ELSEWHERE?

Yes, you can.

IS THERE AN AGE LIMIT?

No, there is no age limit.

WHAT IF MY INFORMATION CHANGES AFTER MY FILM SUBMISSION? Go back to your portal and update the information.

DOES AFRIFF ONLY ACCEPT AFRICAN MOVIES?

No, all international movies are accepted.

WHO ARE THE SPEAKERS?

Speakers and guests are African, local and international film experts, producers, directors, distributors, actors, practitioners, talents etc...

ARE KIDS ALLOWED TO ATTEND?

The animation program is open to kids to view.

WILL THERE BE A FESTIVAL PARTY?

Yes, there will be parties at the end of each day and a closing ceremony on the festival's last day.

WHAT GENRE OF MOVIES WILL BE SHOWN?

The festival shows all genres of movies, it all depends on the movies selected.

WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE AT AFRIFF?

Corporate casual, semi-formal & casual Red carpet for parties and red carpet events.

IS THERE A GATE FEE TO ATTEND THE FESTIVAL?

There is no gate fee to attend the screenings nevertheless you will need to register online as a festivalia to gain access to the festival. However certain events will be strictly by invitation.

All Genres of movies, including short films.

WHAT IS AFRIFF ACADEMY

AFRIFF Talent Development Programme (ADTP) popularly known at AFRIFF ACADEMY is a program targets young African creatives and provides them with the skills and exposure required to succeed. Under ATDP, AFRIFF has now trained over 10,000 young film practitioners in 12 African countries.

AFRIFF ACADEMY is AFRIFF's flagship capacity building initiative and is the most established film training programme in Africa since November 2010.

Every year, at least 15 of the most promising students in each cohort have been sponsored to international film academies including The Montana State University, Relativity Film School Los Angeles, Lyon Film School France and Poland Film School.

Prominent beneficiaries of the AFRIFF Academy include Gideon Okeke (Nigeria) Linda Ihuoma Ejiofor (Nigeria), Osei Owusu Banahene (Ghana), Lydia Gachuhi (Kenya), Ephrem Alemu (Ethiopia) and Adesua Etomi (Nigeria).

2021 cohort, our largest yet, comprises 1000 students from 19 African countries. In support of the film festival, and in order to achieve our goal of empowering 15,000 young African filmmakers by 2025, we are open to funding from international organizations. The funding will go towards international facilitators and training devices. Currently, our esteemed list of partners, which currently includes Access Bank, Nigerian Breweries, the United States Mission, Amazon Prime Video, the Japanese Embassy, The Smithsonian Institute and Multichoice.
